ATTORNEYS FROM ERNST & LINDER LLC ADMITTED TO THE UNITED STATES SUPREME COURT



On June 11, 2012 Dr. Marcus A. Ernst, Hervé N. Linder and Steffanie E. Keim, were admitted to practice before the United States Supreme Court by Chief Justice of the United States, John G. Roberts, Jr. and can now appeal and argue cases in front of the highest court in the land.

The bar admission was done with all nine members of the U.S. Supreme Court convening for the regular business of the court, including the announcement and reading of a court opinion *Elgin v. Department of Treasury* (<http://www.supremecourt.gov/opinions/11pdf/11-45.pdf>) by Associate Justice Clarence Thomas.

The President of the New York State Bar Association, Seymour W. James, who is admitted to practice before the U.S. Supreme Court, made the motion to accept the applicants as members of

the Bar of the Supreme Court of the United States and U.S. Supreme Court Chief Justice John Roberts Jr. admitted Dr. Ernst, Mr. Linder and Ms. Keim to practice before the United States Supreme Court and William K. Suter, Clerk of the Supreme Court of the United States administered the oath.

Following the ceremony in the court room Associate Justice Ruth Bader Ginsburg and Associate Justice Sonia Sotomayor joined the reception to congratulate Dr. Ernst, Mr. Linder, Ms. Keim and the other applicants from New York and welcome them to the Bar of the United States Supreme Court.
